Question

“Firstly I'd like to make a request to see the results of the public consultation, although some figures have been published in the media I have so far been unable to find comprehensive information regarding the end result of this consultation. Any information you can provide relating to opinions expressed would be of interest.

Secondly I'd like to request information regarding the value of the land and the figures relevant to the sale of the land to the Education Funding Agency. Ideally I'm looking for an independent valuation of the land which I assume has taken place and information regarding what the EFA (or other organisations) are actually paying for the land.

Thirdly I'd like to request any information relating to the decision to sell the site to the EFA so that a school can be established. I am aware of the arguments put forward for using the land in such a way, however I'm concerned not all options were explored fully and wish to understand how this decision came about and what other options were considered.”
