"The UK's first victims' commission was launched in Northamptonshire this morning with the aim of promoting the needs of victims of crime.

The new unit, which is to be led by Angela Sarkis, will examine the police and criminal justice system in the county, giving a louder voice to victims of crime in the police force and in courts. It was launched today by Police and Crime Commissioner, Adam Simmonds, together with Chief Constable Adrian Lee and is the first of its kind in England and Wales. The initiative, which will be called Victims' Voice, will look across all the current services which support victims of crime to examine whether the services fully understand and meet their needs."
